Reason

To conform with the requirement of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Informative:

The Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981 makes it an offence to damage or destroy the nest of any wild bird whilst that nest is in use or being built. It is also an offence to take or destroy the egg of any wild bird. It is recommended that this tree be inspected for nesting birds prior to the commencement of works. If nests are found then it is recommended that the advice of either Natural England or a suitably qualified ecologist is sought before any works are undertaken. Your Right of Appeal

Compensation

If you suffer any loss or damage as a result of a condition attached to this consent, you might be entitled to recover compensation from the Council. If you wish to make a claim you must do so within 12 months from the date of this decision (or, if you appeal to the Secretary of State, within 12 months from the date of this decision).
