Further to your last email, please find below the highways response on a separate email as requested. I have attached a Pdf of the drainage report, and the link below contains all data files and CCTV footage requested by highways.

Response received from the Drainage Engineers.

- S38 Plan request - I am unsure why this is required as we understand the existing road is already adopted and no new roads are proposed for adoption.
- S278 Works and investigations - We are scheduled to undertake this work as part of the Detailed Design elements, instruction of which I assume is linked to securing planning. So would assume this could be conditioned subject to HG's approval to prevent further delays.
- The Street lighting element is a third-party design item that would fall under these S278 works; however, we can reach out for quotations in the interim to assist the process.
- CCTV Evidence - Please see attached a copy of the CCTV Drainage report in PDF format and a WeTransfer link to the video files and recorded information. <https://we.tl/t-xYATX5550YDr2UY3>
- I am not sure that the highways gullies will have been surveyed as the focus would have been on the main (UU) drainage, however as per the S38 query the gullies should already be classified as adopted assets and any potential amendments to these would be covered under the proposed S278 works. On this basis, I am not sure this information should be required but any further CCTV investigations insisted upon could be undertaken at the later Design/Construction stages if necessary.

In addition, our client would prefer not to have to installed cycle stores as they become a maintenance issue but would reluctantly accept adding small timber sheds into back gardens if they must be provided.
