

Design and Access Heritage Statement.

Heritage Statement for alterations to listed building No 4A Cross Street Street Whitehaven

Location/dwelling

No 4A Cross Street is a grade 2 listed Georgian town house of 2 storeys in height located close to Whitehaven town centre

Proposals

1. To fit 4 wood burning stoves, 1 in the lounge using existing fireplace, 1 in the office (ground floor front of house) by reinstating original fireplace and 1 in the master bedroom again using the original fireplace and 1 in the 1st floor lounge
2. Fit ¼ height wrought iron window grilles and flower boxes to 4 front windows
3. To raise the lintel (max height) of the door to the garage situated at the end of Cross street/Irish street junction

All flues to be fitted with 904 grade flexible flue liners and chimney pots fitted to chimney stack with low profile weather cowls (stainless Steel mini euro cowls)

Justification

Regarding the garage alterations, doing this work would enable us to park off street as parking in Whitehaven is already difficult plus it would add security benefits
