

Planning permission was granted, but only if after 3yrs we dismantled the lodge, costing over £120, and put the ~~site~~<sup>site</sup> back as it was. (An old railway line)

They also said that it's because we are outside the village boundary, for normal house building, and away from the village amenities.

The only amenities in Rowrah are our "Alpaca Walking" and Ennerdale Brewery which is our neighbour, 5 min walk from our site. No Pubs or Shops - all closed.

We have a holiday lodge on ~~site~~<sup>site</sup> "Alpaca Lodge" which gives the Ennerdale Brewery regular customers

We have a lots of animals on our smallholding.

Alpacas, Donkeys, horses & ponies, Hens & trailhounds. All of which need constant care and someone to care.

We also do livery which means we have other people expensive saddles and bridles ~~etc~~. All of which could be stolen if someone is not on site day & night.

We have a letter from our Vet saying we must live on site.

Our smallholding is surrounded by trees which screen us off from all roads. It is very secluded.

We hope those are sufficient reasons why we need to live permanently on site.
